AFRICANS SOUTH AFRICA PROTEST AGAINST INCORPORATION SOUTH  
WEST AFRICA INTO UNION. PRAY URGE CONTROL TERRITORY BY UNO  
TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL. MANDATE OVER TERRITORY WAS UNDER  
ARTICLE 22 COVENANT LEAGUE OF NATIONS.

AFRICANS SOUTH WEST AFRICA NO SHARE IN GOVERNMENT  
THEREFORE TAKE NO PART IN INCORPORATION NEGOTIATIONS. SOUTH  
AFRICA ITSELF DENIES POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC RIGHTS HER  
8,000,000 AFRICANS.

83 PERCENT LAND RESERVED FOR 2,000,000 EUROPEANS ONLY LESS  
THAN 17 ½ PERCENT FOR 8,000,000 AFRICANS.

ONLY 40 PER CENT AFRICAN CHILDREN ACCOMMODATED IN MISSION  
SCHOOLS.

95 PER CENT AFRICANS ARE IMPRISONED UNDER DISCRIMINATORY  
REGULATIONS AGAINST AFRICANS ONLY. SOUTH AFRICA MUST FIRST  
REMOVE COLOUR BAR, RESTRICTIONS, DISCRIMINATIONS AT HOME.
