Comrade,

On behalf of the National Executive Committee I wish to bring the following to your notice.

I wish to annul all allegations that were graphedded by the ever-antagonistic white press about our national Executive being cleated if SECRET and also that it is a secret Executive The truth is that the Executive was allegated in public during an open session at the close of Congress. ARRESTS AND DETERTIONS:

I wish to inform you about our Leaders who are behind bars. Notibudi Nangore was sentenced to five years imprisonement. Lawyers handling the case have indicated intention to lodge yet another appeal against the sentence to the Chief justice of the Appelate Court. Our Secretary-General Sipho Buthglezi is held in custody while lawyers handling the case are appealling for the reduction of bail which was R1000-00. Another member of our Organisation in dentention is Mkotesceu Motsau of the Sharpevill branch. At the time of writing this circular word had been got through the press that he had appeared for the fourth remand yesterday. Proceedings were held in camera and after the trial he was whisked away bythe security polive at high speed. A colleague Puso Tladi see arrested at the scene and no reasons for has arrest were given. Such intimidatory acts are what we expect as the year unfolds. We should not allow ourselves to be intimidated and recede into fear-infested coccoms. We should portray and pledge Solidarity with our banned, harassed, interrogated and intimidated comrades.
