The extra ordinary meeting of the executive council of the SRC held on the 19-9-1974 at 11pm. Present was Messrs Phaladi, Sedibe, Ledwaba, Mangwatho, Ratlhagane. The president declared the meeting opened at 11pm and handed the chair to the vice-president.

(2) The president moved a motion that the extra ordinary meeting be converted into an ordinary executive council meeting it was seconded by MR. Phaladi.

(3) The motion was adopted unanimously.

(4) The vice-president handed the chair back to the president.

(5) The cor.. secretary read a letter from the law society to the

(6) concerning the subsidy for a trip to U.B.L.S. Lesotho.

(6) The treasurer indicated that the law society spend R95.00 from the budget.

(7) It was decided in principle that the SRC should subsidise the law society.

(8) The executive council of the law society was called in at 11.40pm to furnish the executive council of the SRC with information on which the subsidy could be determined.

(9) Number of persons going to Lesotho on educational tour is 35

The means of transport is a University bus. It is free.

(10) The executive council of the law society is to spend. Per-capita-per-day-is-R6.50-two days at R6.50 per capita per day. The matter was deliberated on.

(11) The chairman put the matter to vote. MR. Mangwatho registered non-participation in voting. It was decided that the law society be subsidised. The subsidy was put at R145,00.

(12) The letter from the Univ. chess club was read and it was decided that the chess club conducted its competition unpro-  
-cidually and therefore can not be subsidised.

(13) A letter from Univ. Social Worker's Organization was read and deliberated on it was decided that the U.S.W.O. is a sub-committee of Arts council which is sub-committee of the SRC. It is not the Arts council which could be subsidised, not U.S.W.O.
