The Republic? - a Nationalist ideal:

As long ago as 1942 Nationalist leader, Dr Malan, set out the objectives of the purified Nationalist Party as 'to strive for the establishment of an Afrikaner republic.'

Why a republic?

- # to mark the triumph of Afrikaner nationalism
- * to remove any vestiges of the British constitutional system which undermined the sovereignty and integrity of the Afrikaner majority of S.A.
- * to establish an emotional growth point for the entrenchment of Afrikaner ideals

Who's republic?

- no blacks were represented in the conventions of 1909 that led to the founding of the Union of South Africa in 1910.
 - # by the Land Tenure Act of 1913 blacks could not own land in certain areas.
- no blacks were represented in the London conferences between 1926-1931 which virtually granted independence to South Africa by the British Statute of Westminister of 1931.

"The parliament of the Union shall be the sovereign legislative power in and over the Union, and notwithstanding anything 'n any other law contained, no Act of Parliament of the U.K. and Northern Ireland passed after the swenthday of December, 1931, shall extend or be deemed to extend, to the Union as part of the law of the Union unless extended thereto by an Act of the Parliament of the Union."

- # Africans in the Cape were removed from the Common Voters' Roll in 1936.
- in 1948 Nationalists came into power.
- * security acts silenced all opposition
- # Cape Coloureds removed from Cormon Voters' Roll 1956. # Bantu Education | Erosion of academic freedom # Seperate Universities
