- 3. That South African history has shown that security clampdowns are likely to exacerbate conflict.

# Therefore Resolves

- 1. To reject the basis for the state of emergency as a means to end the violence.
- 2. To call on the government to address itself to the underlying legitimate grievances present in the country.
- 3. To call upon all students and staff to attend the student assembly which will discuss the state of emergency at 12h30 today in the Students' Union Arcade.
