May
4th 1978
at least 750
Namibians
were mas-
sacred by
the SADF.
The attack
on Kassinga
was a joint
operation
which consis-
-ted of ±1500
troops from both
the army and the
airforce. The victims
were civilians in a
refugee transit camp
at Kassinga, 250 km
inside Angola. The
majority were old men
women and children.
Kassinga was not SWAPO
headquarters, as Pretoria
claimed it was, nor was it
a military installation.
464 were wounded, 112 were
taken as prisoners of war, while
the almost 800 dead were buried
in a mass grave at Kassinga. The
prisoners of war were interned in a
camp at Marienthal for the next six
years. The camp was kept secret from
the outside world for all that time.
We remember the victims of Kassinga and
call for freedom in Namibia.....
