EMERGENCY

REGULATIONS IN TERMS OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY
ACT, 1953

By virtue of the powers vested in me as President (1) of the Republic of South Africa, 1953 (Act No. 47 of 1953). I hereby make with effect from 1 July 1953, the regulations mentioned in Schedule I, in which the existence of a state of emergency has been declared in terms of section 2 of the said Act as from 1 July 1953, the regulations contained in Schedule II, and in terms of section 2(1) of the said Act, the hereby declared regulations shall apply also in all the other magisterial districts in the Republic of South Africa with effect from 1 July 1953.
