
The Constitution



The constitution produced by Kempton Park is only an INTERIM one. It contains important things which may end up in the PERMANENT one, which will have to be written by the new Parliament. It has a Bill of Rights, and certain CONSTITUTIONAL PRINCIPLES which will guide the new Parliament in writing the final Constitution.



The Final Constitution should be completed by 1996. It must be passed by a two-thirds majority of both houses of Parliament. The Constitutional Court will advise Parliament in writing the new Constitution. If Parliament fails to agree, then a national referendum with a 60% majority will be required. Otherwise a new general election.
