

# **Rules for elections**

## Standing for elections/voting

Every NUMSA member who is paid up can:

- · vote for new shop stewards in their factory or
- stand as a shop steward. Old shop stewards can also stand again if they are nominated.




### **Nominations**

- Your NUMSA organiser will ask you to nominate people to stand as shop stewards.
- Put forward the name of a worker who you think will be good as a shop steward. Get someone else to second the name.

### **Elections**

- If there are more names nominated than the number of shop stewards needed, then there will be an election.
- Your organiser must tell you at least three days before the election, where and when to vote and who are the names you can vote for.
- 3. NUMSA's constitution says you can choose to vote:
- by secret ballot (if more than 10% of the members ask for it) (use the form in the envelope), if you choose secret ballot, then make your mark with a cross next to the name(s) you want.
  - or by show of hands.
- 4. Once the organiser has counted the votes, s/he will tell you who your new shop stewards are.
