

INTERNAL RECONSTRUCTION COMMITTEE

CAPE REGION REPORT.

26th August, 1975.

On the request of our people inside, to meet a member of our Committee in Z. Conrad R left for Z. On the 30th last month. The person concerned was met.

The report from the contact is as follows:-

1. C.T. A leadership of three has been formed in Gugulethu.
2. Working groups on basis of the H. Plan Number of people in a group not more than five, and not less than three.
3. Every member of each group is to organise another group thus the whole area is becoming organised.
4. Every member pays 20 cents a month. It is with this money that we send R5.00 to each prisoner in the Island, and other prisons. It is also from this money that they pay cover costs for the up keep of the visitors who visit the prisoners from time to time. They appealed to the Church Council to help them in this cost but received no help.
5. Island leaders are well organised, and well informed.
6. The structure is organised on the same line as C.T. in P.E.
7. At the suggestion of the Island a Comrade from there has been sent to the Eastern part of the region to organise both the trade union movement and our organisation.
8. He was given a rousing reception in P.E. But this alerted the enemies and police surveillance was increased. He had to lie low, and some one else was sent on his place in the area of P.E.
9. The person went to C.T. to report the situation. C.T. briefed him on their structure, and gave him cash.
10. There is regular contact and Coordination between the groups C.T. P.E. E.L. Transkei etc. Every second week a representative from C.T. visits E.P.
11. Mdantsane is one of the well organised places.
12. They are working against Bantustans, and for the destruction of the Democratic Party, which confuses our people, as Part leaders of ANC (OSCAR) are now leaders of the Democratic Party.
13. (a) He emphasised the need of contact with other provinces.  
(b) Material help to our people clothes.
