## BLACK CONSCIOUSNESS - BLACK POWER

Some of these articles happen to be liberal, and at least one journalist to vouce our the Nationalist Party's viewpoint. The radio Bantu is the most sickening perpertuators of separate development and white exclusiveness, of late it has turned into a mouthpiece of the police force.

White students grow-up knowing that they are to maintain from other human beings, what is supposed to be for whites, this can be clearly seen in their curculum prepares student who are to serve in their defence force. This is some people say Black Consiousness is racism. abhorrently untrue for Black Consciousness transforms you from the docile animal to a human-being who knows that he is first black and oppressed. Black Consciousness stifles the individualistic tendency which is incalcated by the legalised rasism and the capitalist system in the country ashamed to look back and accept the communalistic living of our fore-fathers created no socio-economic problems in that widows were taken care of, when a child is born the community is happly for that child is for that particular community with the result, subsidised by the richer and is expected to pay-back when he has accumulated enough.
