Has since filed an application with the Secretary General's Office to resign from the ANC. No final decision has yet been communicated to the Education Department.

## Problem Areas:

The Scholarships desk at HQ has contantly been confronted with the following problems:-

UNESCO: - Limitations in getting assistance. Accessibility to UNESCOO differently organised from other sponsors in the region. Always referred to Education Officer in Dar es Salaam or the Projects Officer at HQ for authorisation.

ILO: - Lack of clarity on the extent of assistance from ILO. Limited access to the projects desk in the Education Department Office.

CUSO: - Met CUSO Representative on schola ship matters, although attention of the meeting became dominated by project problems to the neglect of scholarship matters. Appointment later concluded between the CUSO representative and Comrade Hintsa. No feed back was received.

- Need for clarity on working relations between Education Department Office and Projects Office, DMD and Wemen's Section on scholarship matters.
- Need for clarity on the French Course.
- WUS Zambia maladministration and securing of leans for WUS sponsees from Treasurer General's Office. Matters taken up with WUS HQ in Geneva. Report to be availed once discussions have been finalised.

UNHCR: - No budget for ANC. Matter being fellowed up.

- Need for clarification on the powers of the NSC vis-a-vis HQ.

  Refer Pg. 40 NEDUC 1983 Report on Responsibility of the Student placement:
  "In case of HQ, departments are expected to channel applications through the Secretary for Education, whilst in all other regions this will be done through the Chief Representative's Office, except HQ where this will be done by the relevant head of the National Department."
- Skewed distribution of our students to various agencies for spensorship, as reflected in the above list, with more reliance on WUS and LWE and little,
- if any accessibility to UNESCO and ILO, through the Projects desk at HQ or the Education Officer in Dar es Salaam, reflects lack of effective dentralisation on scholarship matters and the resultant failure to evolve an effective collective approach.
- Whereas a scholarship desk has been established in the HQ, scholarship effers have been made to candidates in the region without the attention of the Education Department Office. This trend has tended to undermine efforts at placing candidates who have long applied for sponsorship.
